



FAIR PLAY CODE FOR COACHES

1. I will be reasonable when scheduling games and practices, remembering that young athletes have other interests and obligations.
 2. I will teach my athletes to play fairly and to respect the rules, the officials and our opponents.
 3. I will ensure that all athletes get equal instruction, support and playing time.
 4. I will not ridicule, or yell at my athletes for making mistakes or for performing poorly. I will remember that children play to have fun and must be encouraged to have confidence in themselves.
 5. I will make sure that equipment and facilities are safe and match the athletes' ages and abilities.
 6. I will remember that children need a coach they can respect. I will be generous with praise and set a good example in my dealings with my players, other coaches and game officials.
 7. If I disagree with an official, I will discuss the matter calmly either at the half or after the game.
 8. I will obtain proper training and continue to upgrade my coaching skills.

FAIR PLAY CODE FOR PLAYERS

1. I will participate because I want to, not just because my parents or coaches want me to.
 2. I will play by the rules and in the spirit of the game.
 3. I will control my temper at all times - fighting and mouthing off can spoil the activity for everybody.
 4. I will respect my opponents.
 5. I will do my best to be a true team player.
 6. I will remember that winning isn't everything - that having fun, improving skills, making friends and doing my best are also important.
 7. I will acknowledge all good plays/performances - those of my team and of my opponents.
 8. I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me. I will accept their decisions and show them respect.
 9. Regardless of what I think, the Referee is always right and I will not dispute any call.
 10. I will return all equipment and uniforms to the Club promptly at the end of season.

FAIR PLAY CODE FOR PARENTS

1. I will not force my child to participate in sports.
2. I will remember that my child plays sport for his or her enjoyment, not mine.
3. I will encourage my child to play by the rules and resolve conflicts without resorting to verbal abuse, hostility or violence.
4. I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game/event.
5. I will make my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and trying hard.
6. I will never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
7. I will remember that children learn by example. I will applaud good plays/performance by both my child's team and its opponents.
8. I will never question an officials judgment or honesty in public.
9. I will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from children's sporting activities.
10. I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteer coaches who give their time to provide sport activities for my child.
11. I will return all equipment and uniforms to the Club promptly at the end of season. This helps to keep the cost of sport at a reasonable level.
